PARENT/CHILD REUNITE AREA: As a reminder, each registered child will have received 2 DUPLICATE BIBS at the expo. Parents are welcome to accompany their children on the course during the Covenant Kids Run IF AND ONLY IF they wear this duplicate bib.

For those who instead will meet their child(ren) at the Finish Line, we are happy to provide a Parent/Child Reunite area.

- BE SURE AND BRING YOUR DUPLICATE BIB WITH YOU AT ALL TIMES.
- Parents and spectators will enter Neyland Stadium through Gate 21 (northwest corner of the stadium) and sit in Sections A-F or R-Z while waiting to view their child's crossing of the finish line at the 50-yardline.
- The Parent/Child reunite area is located on the West Sideline (bottom on below map) and can be accessed by walking down the provided steps to the field. These steps will be available only in Section T.
- Before exiting the field via Gate 21A, volunteers will check to make sure that the bib on the child and the bib on the parent are an exact match. University of Tennessee Police will patrol and assist in the exit area.
- Families will then be able to exit the stadium via Gate 21A
- NOTE: No child will be allowed to leave the field at Neyland Stadium unless they have been checked by University of Tennessee Police to have a matching bib with an accompanying parent or guardian.

SPECTATOR GATE: All parents and spectators enter through Gate 21 (see map below). If arranging to meet other friends and family at the stadium, please note that seating will only be available in Sections A-F and R-Z.

PARKING: The best place to park is in the G10 garage. Please plan to park there before 5:30 pm to insure you do not get caught in road closures for the races. If you do watch your child start, we strongly recommend that you walk to the finish line at the stadium in order to meet him/her. It is approximately a 5 minute walk from the Clinch Avenue Bridge (start line) to Neyland Stadium (finish line).
